2020 was definitely one for the record books. Our COVID pandemic season began with our wedding being cancelled. The week before our wedding, Miami was placed on lockdown and everything was postponed. Despite the fact that the coronavirus had forced our wedding ceremony to be postponed, Gordon and I still wanted to get married and Pastor Rich and Pastor Tina were selfless and agreed to marry us.

Through the struggle of the pandemic we were never alone. We had our community within our church family. We did life together, regardless of what we were going through. We chose to do life together. Generation Church was intentional with their actions. My time during connect groups is something I will always be thankful and grateful for. It taught me the importance of community and it showed me that I am not the only one who goes through certain things in life and that there are other people who are willing to move with you, coach you and support you. It was such a blessing to be able to connect with others on a regular basis and share what we were going through each week.

Each year Generation Church picks a vision for the year. "Wherever the sound" was the chosen vision for 2020. It couldn't have been more appropriate. I experienced "Wherever the sound" firsthand. On October 5th, I experienced the biggest scare of my life. As my family and I went for our regular afternoon run and Elle rode her bike next to me, Elle asked me if she could go be next to her dad, so I told her yes and to be careful. As Elle approached her dad, she ran into his leg, which resulted in her falling and taking a hard hit to her head. After calling Fire Rescue, I then immediately called Pastor Tina and asked her if she could start praying for Elle because we honestly didn't know what was going to happen next. With Pastor Rich on speaker, he began to pray over our sweet daughter. Once he was done praying, fire rescue arrived and transported our daughter. As Elle was being intubated, our pastors arrived at the hospital! Pastor Rich held our hands and he prayed for Elle. Shortly after our pastors left, I got up and fully surrendered Elle to the Lord. Something I was deeply struggling with prior to this incident. I told God, "She is yours God. She is yours before mine and you can have her. You can do whatever it is that you want to do with her." After surrendering Elle to God, I received this peace that surpassed any kind of understanding or explaining. The most touching part of that night was the selflessness and thoughtfulness of my church. They started a 24-hour prayer chain for our sweet Elle! The love my family and I received from my church still leaves me speechless. I will forever be grateful and thankful for every one of you! We went through this experience as a community. I have to tell you; I've never experienced this outpouring of love and community from a church before! This is just one of the reasons why Generation Church has our hearts! As they quickly learned of our sound (wherever the sound), they guickly moved towards us and walked us through until we left the hospital and even after. God saved Elle - it was through faith and prayer that Elle did not suffer any major injuries! No one could explain why Elle stopped breathing or how her recovery was so quick!




